

Day Use Rules

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) facility rules provide a safe, enjoyable experience for everyone while protecting natural resources.

Site Usage

Day Use Area open from dawn to dusk.

- Day use fees, where applicable, include one vehicle with one towed camper or boat, or one RV, per site.
- If you have a reservation, please confirm arrival with Area Host.
- Fees are not transferable to other recreation sites unless approved by Area Host.
- Please make sure all vehicles and equipment are contained within designated parking areas.

Environmental Stewardship

Take care of the forests; burn local wood to avoid spreading pests and diseases.

- You may use dead wood for fuel. Do not cut or damage living plants or trees.
- Conserve water and keep the water supply safe. Do not clean fish, bathe or wash in streams, lakes or at faucets.
- Keep wildlife wild and do not feed them. Maintain a clean site.
- Help preserve vegetation and soils. Keep vehicles on designated roadways and use existing trails.
- Preserve our shared history. Do not remove or disturb cultural or historical resources.
- Quagga and zebra mussels from the Eastern US are devastating for our lakes, reservoirs and rivers. If you've visited infested waters, check your boat and equipment for the mussels.
- Please leave your site as you found it for others to enjoy.
- Outdoor showers are not allowed.

Courtesy and Safety

- Visitors who do not respect the rights and privacy of other visitors, engage in behavior that negatively impacts others' use and enjoyment of the recreation facility (e.g., excessive noise, unsolicited photography, infringing on others' personal belongings, etc.), or do not follow day use area rules, may be asked to leave the facility without refund.
- **Vehicles.** California vehicle Code applies to all vehicles, including bicycles. Vehicles must observe the 5-mph speed limit and travel in the direction posted. Pedestrians have the right of way. Street legal vehicles may be operated to enter or exit the facility. OHV non-street legal vehicles are not to be operated in PG&E facilities.
- **Help prevent forest fires.** Campfires are only allowed where designated and must be supervised at all times. Fully extinguish fires and properly put out and dispose of cigarettes, pipes, and matches when leaving the site.
- Campfires and charcoal grill fires may be prohibited at any time by PG&E, the campground host, or other PG&E representative's assessment of fire risk.
- **Be safe.** Use of fireworks, chain saws, bows and arrows or any firearms is prohibited in or near recreation areas.
- **Trash.** Please do not throw trash in toilets; deposit garbage or recycling in the containers provided. Properly disposing of trash will help prevent issues with the wildlife and reduce expense. Do not put ashes in garbage cans - campground hosts will remove ashes and dispose of as needed.
- **Pets.** Pets are allowed for a fee, where applicable. They must be vaccinated, leashed and cleaned up after. Please prevent excessive barking. Pets are not safe or happy when left unattended.
- This facility may close at any time due to unforeseen health and safety issues.
- Keep noise level at a reasonable and respectable level.
